

Tonight's Speaker -BOBBY HUMPHREY

"Change is possible through a relationship with Christ."

Drafted 17th in the 1St round of the Supplement Draft by the Denver Broncos, Bobby became the first rookie to rush for over 1,000 yards. He is also one of 10 running backs to rush for back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons in the 1st two years. The Broncos were in the Super Bowl during his rookie year in 1990. In 1991, Bobby was selected to the Pro Bowl. Then in 1992, he was traded to the Miami Dolphins. In 1992

he was the team leading receiver in pass receptions. He played with Miami in 1992 through 1993.

In 2004, Bobby was inducted into the Alabama Sports Hall of Fame.

He was the Birmingham Arena Cup Steeldogs football coach from 1999 through 2005 where he coached longer than anyone else in AF2 history and holds the record for most wins in the league.

Bobby and his wife Barbara have 5 children and live in Birmingham. He has a degree in Social Work and is very active in the southeast with various businesses and charities.

He is active in church and speaks to youth groups as often as he can. His best advice is "change is possible through a relationship with Christ."



JOHN SEWELL SCHOLARSHIP

John Sewell was a cousin of Joe Sewell who was dedicated to the game of baseball and a positive influence on young people. After a successful business career, John spent almost all of his available time working with young people. He admitted his greatest weakness in life by saying, "I just can't say no to a kid that wants to play ball. I'll do anything to help him."

In 2000, John went on a mission to find his cousin's famous bat. When it was found in Birmingham, John had the opportunity to hold it and make the connection to his famous cousin from years past.

John continued to coach and be a part of youth baseball until his death in 2003. He was a resident of Coosada. His wife Billie serves on the Board.

Purpose of the Joe Sewell Memorial Award

The purpose of the Joe Sewell Memorial Award is to recognize outstanding high school senior athletes, who by their actions have consistently represented the highest ideals of Christian leadership in athletics. Approximately 28 high school seniors from across Elmore County are nominated for this award. One boy and one girl will be selected as the overall Joe Sewell Award recipient. Each will receive a \$1,000 John Sewell Scholarship. Their high school coaches and administrators nominate the students. Approximately 20 ninth graders are also nominated and receive a certificate.
